Carbon Monoxide:

Carbon Monoxide is a colorless, odorless gas that can be caused by various factors. Here are a few common causes.

- Carbon Monoxide can be caused by an oven or stove top that is not working properly.
- Carbon Monoxide can be caused by an oven or stove top that has been operating for a long period of time with no ventilation or fresh air from the outside. If an oven or stove will be used for an extended time, especially during the Sabbath or holidays, slightly opening a window will allow fresh air to ventilate the room and help prevent carbon monoxide build up.
- Carbon Monoxide can be caused by gas heat, oil heat and car exhaust.
- If there is a Carbon Monoxide alarm, CALL THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IMMEDIATELY.
